THE FINE PRINT ENROLLMENT IN AND PAYMENT OF YOUR DEPOSIT FOR THE TOUR, CONSTITUTES YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONDITIONS AND STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY.

INCLUDED IN PRICE:

1) Deluxe motor coaches, First Class / Superior First Class hotels, guided sightseeing, entrance fees to sites visited, breakfast & dinner per brochure;
2) Gratuities of \$210 for tour guide or cruise director, local host, driver, local guides, and/or ships' crew; gratuities on ferries, and cruise ships.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:

Not included in your package are passports, airfare, visas, COVID-19 tests, vaccinations, laundry, lunches, telephone, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, travel insurance, excess baggage fees, any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the date you register for your trip, and all other items not specifically mentioned.

PAYMENT:

A full deposit of \$500 per person is required at time of registration. Final payment must be made in the form of a check (credit cards are only accepted for initial deposit, any remaining payments must be in check form) and is due no later than 90-days prior to departure. Registrations received after 90-days prior to departure must be accompanied by full payment. There may be a late fee of \$195 for all payments or new registrations received 75-60 days prior to departure. All tour prices are based on a minimum group size of 26 passengers for prices to be valid. The following supplements may apply for smaller groups: 25-20 travelers, a \$100 per person supplement; 19-15 travelers, a \$150 per person supplement; 14-10 travelers, a \$195 per person supplement. If group size is less than 10 travelers, the tour may be cancelled due to lack of participation. If final (full) payment is not received by Imagine Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as Imagine) 60-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of \$500 will be forfeited and additional fees may apply. Imagine reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the Euro or Stirling Pound based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date (05/23/22) when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church. All payments are required in US Funds.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While Imagine will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 60 days prior to departure. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a single room supplement charge: \$844 for basic itinerary.

ITINERARY and CHANGES:

Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, Imagine reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms \$225/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/ or departure city listed, by the passenger, must be provided in writing to Imagine no later than 100-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger. All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 plus any applicable airline fees. All tours are final at 75-days prior to departure. No changes and/or additions may be made to the tour after that time.

LAND ONLY:

Land Only price is \$3772 per person. Price does not include international flights. Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. We recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties, as the group's flights may change. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 per person.

AIRLINE TICKETS:

In order to keep prices low, Imagine does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights to your final destination. Imagine also does not guarantee the group will be on the same flights, particularly if registering 90 days prior to departure. Flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not Imagine. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded once issued. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. Imagine is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept them as partial payment for air transportation. Deviations by the passenger, from the group's scheduled flights, could result in different routings/air carriers. Airline changes, if allowable, made by the passenger after final payment has been made, may incur additional fees.

VISAS:

Applicable visas will be obtained by Imagine for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting. Imagine is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

FLIGHT TIMES:

All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. Imagine is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

CANCELLATION FEES:

Any passenger cancelling from the day of registration to 100 days prior to departure will be charged a \$300 non-refundable administrative fee per person plus any airline penalties, if applicable. You will also be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room from 59 days prior until the date of departure. The following charges also apply: 99-60 days = \$500; 59-45 days = \$1750; 44-25 days = 75% of total cost; 24 days to day of departure = 100% of total cost. All Cancellations must be received in writing. On or after the day of departure there is no refund for any services not used. We strongly recommend you purchase travel insurance. If Imagine cancels the tour due to lack of participation, there will be a charge of \$150 deducted from the amount refunded to each passenger for administrative fees plus any airline penalties if applicable.

TRIP RESCHEDULING:

Imagine and/or Trip leader reserve the right to re-schedule the dates of the Trip to future dates TBD due to governmental action, pandemic, or other circumstances beyond their control. Should that occur, all travelers will be rebooked for the new dates. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates may cancel their participation and will be assessed a cancellation fee of up to \$300 per person, plus any additional penalties/fees imposed by ground operator(s), airlines, or other vendors. Travelers can transfer to another available tour up to one year from their original departure date.

PASSPORT:

Each passenger is responsible for making sure that they have a valid passport that has an expiration date at least six months after the date of return from their trip.

A copy of your valid passport must be submitted to our office by 90 days prior to departure.

This represents the entire agreement between the passenger and his agent, the travel agent, the tour host, and the tour operator. Imagine reserves the right to refuse or revoke travel to anyone who is, in the sole judgment of Imagine, incapable of group travel. Day 1 – Sunday, June 18: Depart U.S.A. (International Airfare is not included)

When booking your flights to Ireland, you will want to book your flights to arrive at Cork, Ireland on Monday morning, June 19th.

Day 2 – Monday, June 19: Arrive in Cork, Ireland

Begin the tour on the southern tip of the Emerald Isle, with arrival in Cork. The group will waste no time in starting their sightseeing, as they head to nearby Blarney Castle. The castle building dates to the 15th century and is home to the Stone of Eloquence, more famously known as the 'Blarney Stone'. If you dare, position yourself upside-down over a sheer drop to kiss the stone, said to give the gift of eloquence. Transfer to Cork, with the remainder of the day free before a welcome in a local pub or restaurant. Overnight in Cork.

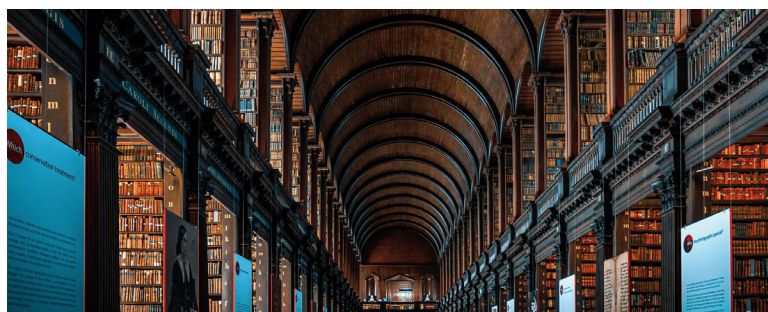
Day 3 – Tuesday, June 20: Cork, Limerick, Clare, Galway, Clifden

The group will head northwest today, driving through the counties of Cork, Limerick, and Clare, to be confronted with the imposing Cliffs of Moher. These sea cliffs, on the southwestern edge of the Burren, run for almost 10 miles along the country's western Atlantic coast, and are understandably one of the most photographed natural features in the country. Following a walk along the cliffs and a visit to the visitor center, the group will re-board the coach to continue to the city of Galway this afternoon, with some free time to explore. The city is the fourth most populous in the Republic of Ireland is known for its cultural and arts festivals. This evening the group will stay in a nearby countryside castle hotel (subject to availability), with dinner at the hotel. Overnight in Clifden.



Day 4 – Wednesday, June 21: Clifden, Dublin

The group is Dublin-bound today and will visit some key sights of central Ireland along the way. First is the site of Clonmacnoise, a ruined monastery complex which by the 9th century was a major center of religion, learning, trade, and craftsmanship. Many of the high kings of Tara and Connacht were buried here over the years. The next stop for the group is the thoroughbred horse breeding facility near Kildare. Irish is known for its horse breeding prowess and the National Stud visitor center provides fascinating insight into the tradition and history of this. The decades-old surrounding gardens are also of international renown – with the Japanese Gardens held to be among the finest in all of Europe. Dinner is at local pub or restaurant in Dublin. Overnight in Dublin.



Day 5 – Thursday, June 22: Dublin

Dublin, the capital of Ireland, is a reasonably small city, however what this now cosmopolitan, contemporary city lacks in size it makes up for in passion and character. On a full day guided city tour, the group will see sights including Dublin Castle (which, before secession in 1922, was the seat of the British government in Ireland) and St. Patrick's Cathedral (the national cathedral of the Church of Ireland, dating back over 800 years). Trinity College (whose alumni include Oscar Wilde, Bram Stoker, Samuel Beckett, Chris de Burgh, and Aisling Bea) houses the famous Book of Kells, an illuminated manuscript Gospel book and one of the finest examples of such work in existence. This afternoon, the group will also visit the Guinness Storehouse, to learn the history of the nation's most famous export, as well as having the opportunity to pour a perfect pint of the 'black stuff' as Arthur Guinness intended. Dinner is at your leisure tonight, overnight in Dublin.

Day 6 – Friday, June 23: Belfast

The group will head north to Belfast and enjoy a famous Black Cab taxi tour to see the murals around the city and to learn about the history of a city which saw extreme cultural and political tensions during the 20th century. Next, the group will visit the state-of-the-art Titanic Belfast exhibition, with Belfast the site at which the doomed ship was constructed during its shipbuilding heyday. Remainder of day free. Dinner tonight is at your leisure, not included. Overnight in Belfast.

Day 7 – Saturday, June 24: Dublin, Belfast, Glasgow

The group will head north into Northern Ireland, bound for Belfast ferry terminal. Sailing across the Irish Sea to Scotland, on a clear day the group may be lucky enough to see the peninsula that is home to the Mull of Kintyre in the distance. On arrival at Cairnryan, the group will head straight to the Robert Burns Birthplace Museum in Ayrshire, exploring the state-of-the-art exhibition as well as having the opportunity to enter the old cottage in which the famous Scots poet was born in 1759. Dinner is at local restaurant or pub in Glasgow this evening. Overnight in Glasgow.

Day 8 – Sunday, June 25: Glasgow, Perth, Perthshire

The Glengoyne Distillery is one of many acclaimed single malt whiskey makers in Scotland and will welcome our group this morning for a tour and, more importantly, a tasting. Stirling Castle will be the next port of call, one of the largest and most significant castles in Scottish history. The castle was used as a royal residence before the union with England, while many Scottish Kings and Queens were crowned here. It was also the location where Mary Queen of Scots died in 1542. The small town of Callander, the 'Gateway to the Highlands', is home to various woolen mill outlets, selling some of Scotland's finest woolen products. After some time to buy souvenirs, the group will transfer to their hotel near to the town of Perth. Dinner is included at the hotel, overnight in Perthshire.

Day 9 – Monday, June 26: Perthshire, St. Andrews, Edinburgh

Balmoral Castle, which opens its door to visitors in the summer months, is owned by Queen Elizabeth II and

has been a royal residence of the British royal family since the middle of the 19th century. Her Majesty usually spends the summer holiday at Balmoral. The next stop of the tour, St Andrews, also has a royal connection, as the University counts both Prince William and Kate Middleton among its alumni and is understood to be where they met. The town is also home to one of Scotland's most famous golf courses, the Old Course – availability permitting, the group will enjoy a guided tour of the course, before transferring south to Edinburgh. Dinner is at your leisure tonight, overnight in Edinburgh.

Day 10 – Tuesday, June 27: Edinburgh

Edinburgh, or 'Auld Reekie', is one of the finest cities in the UK, not to mention one of the most walkable. A full day guided tour will include a visit to the Royal Mile, the main thoroughfare through the Old Town of Edinburgh connecting Edinburgh Castle and the Palace of Holyroodhouse which is almost exactly one Scots mile (longer than an English mile) in length. The Palace of Holyroodhouse, the official residence of the British Monarch in Scotland, is home to a plethora of antiquities and artwork. In the Royal Botanic Gardens, the group will have the chance to shelter from the supposedly perpetual Scottish summer rain inside the glasshouse! A farewell dinner is included tonight at a traditional Scottish pub or restaurant. Overnight in Edinburgh.



Day 11 – Wednesday, June 28: Depart Edinburgh (International Airfare is not included)

Morning transfer to Edinburgh Airport for your return flight back to the U.S.A.
